CONDUCT OF THE STUDENTS

1. Every student should pay special attention to her outfit, it should be modest, neat and tidy and Students are not allowed to wear Jeans and shorts.
2. Students must greet the teachers, whenever they come across them.
3. When the teacher enters the classroom, the students must rise and stand until the teacher asks them to sit.
4. Students must leave the classroom only after obtaining permission from the teacher.
5. Students are responsible for the furniture and other amenities provided for them. They must not damage or disturb or displace or misplace them.
6. Students must behave well inside and outside the college in such a way that they maintain the good name of the college as well as their behavior.
7. Ragging is strictly prohibited, either inside the college campus or outside. The student, who indulges in this offence, will be dismissed from the college as per the Govt. order and criminal proceedings will also be initiated as per the latest law.
8. Students who travel by bus are to show due respect and courtesy to the teachers, old persons, and pregnant women.
9. During the Examinations, conducted by the University or by the college authorities, mere possession of extraneous material like paper – bits will be considered an offense and the student shall face disciplinary action. As per the Educational Rules, the Principal has every right to punish the students for their misbehavior by way of levy of fines, suspensions, and expulsion.

RULES OF ATTENDANCE

1. A Student should not be absent from the college without giving a leave letter. It should be endorsed by the parent or guardian or the hostel warden.
2. In case of sickness and other unavoidable circumstances. Extending leave beyond the three days, the students will have to produce medical certificates.

3. Absence for one period in any session will be marked absent for the entire session.
4. A Student should not leave the college premises during the working hours of the college without getting permission from the Head of Dept. In spite of taking leave with permission of the Head of the Department the student must bring a letter from their parents. Parents will have to support them with valid reasons.
5. A Student, who has absent herself for more than seven days, will have her name struck off the rolls.
6. Absence for tests, composition, and any other special classes shall be severely dealt with.

COLLEGE TEST AND EXAMINATIONS

Monthly tests, CIA – I and II examinations, and model examinations will be conducted. Progress cards will be sent to the parents for their perusal.

LIBRARY

- Students must enter the Library leaving their personal belongings in the place allotted for the same.
- Students must show their college identity cards and get library cards from the Librarian.
- Library books will be issued on producing library cards.
- A Student can keep a book for a fortnight from the date of issue and return the same to the Library on time. If the books are not returned on the due date, a fine of Re.1 per day including holidays will be levied.
- No one is allowed to sublet the books taken by her. Students must maintain perfect silence in the library.
- Students must, on receiving books, examine them and if any damage is found it must be reported to the Librarian. They will be held responsible for any damage that may be found afterward.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- Physical Education is compulsory for the students. All the students must attend these classes daily. Annual attendance and progress certificates will not be issued by the Principal unless the candidate has achieved at least 75% of the attendance in Physical Education Training, conducted in the College.
- No student shall be exempted from the Physical Education class unless her incapacity is declared by the Medical Officer.

- One-year Mess, Room Rent & Other Charges (to be paid in two installments)
- Fees are subjected to revision
- Hostel Facility is available for the students

- Students cannot go home unnecessarily by themselves.
- Only Parents or guardians can pick up their children during the holidays.
